



# Little Cataraqi Creek Conservation Area



## Little Cataraqi Creek

Connect with nature at this 394 hectare site in all seasons. There are areas of marsh, field, and forest habitat for nature appreciation, education and outdoor recreation facilities. **Entry Fee:**

\$5 for adults, \$3.50 for children 12 and under, maximum fee of \$15 per vehicle (special event pricing may apply). Annual passes are available for \$95 and provide admission for one year.

## Activities & Facilities

**Hiking and Dog Walking:** During the winter months (January and February) the trail network is groomed and track set for cross-country skiing. Please do not walk or walk your dog in the track-set trails.

**Cross-Country Skiing:** looped trail network crosses woodlands, wetlands and field areas. 13 km of trails are groomed and track set for cross-country skiing in January and February when conditions permit. Ski rentals and lessons are available at the Outdoor Centre on the weekends.

**Snowshoeing:** Trail 5 is left ungroomed for snowshoers along with the Serve Road to the dam and the sugar bush. Please do not walk or snowshoe on the groomed ski trails. Snowshoe rentals are available at the Outdoor Centre on the Weekends.

**Outdoor Centre:** snack bar, washrooms, observation tower, winter equipment rentals. Nature and environmental programs are offered on weekends from Sept. to May. Meeting rooms are available for rent; to make a booking call 613-546-4228 ext. 222.

**Wildlife Viewing & Nature Appreciation:** the wetlands, woods, and reservoir areas provide many opportunities for wildlife viewing and nature appreciation.

**Sugar Bush:** Home to our Maple Madness program each March. Includes interpretive displays, wagon rides, pancakes and maple syrup.

## To help protect Little Cataraqi Creek Conservation Area and to make sure all visitors have an enjoyable experience, please:

- No camping or overnight parking.
- Keeps dogs on a leash (2 m length) at all times. Don't forget to stoop and scoop. Dogs are not permitted in the beach area.
- Stay on the marked trails. This helps prevent damage to sensitive areas and soil erosion. Do not walk off trail, we are trying to encourage natural regeneration of the forest.
- Do not litter. If you find litter, please pick it up and deposit it in the garbage can. Pack in and pack out - leave only footprint, take only photos.
- No removal of vegetation. Do not damage, disturb, or remove any structure, rock, plant, animal, or other property, living or dead. Picking or digging up wildflowers or other plants is prohibited.
- No fires, hunting.
- No ATVs or motorized vehicles on trails.
- Remember that alcoholic beverages are not permitted.

## Winter Trail Etiquette:

Our groomed and track set cross-country ski trails are a unique feature in our area and are very time consuming to produce and keep in good shape. Please respect the trails and the time and effort we put into them by following the trail etiquette below. Thank you.

- Do not walk, snowshoe, or walk your dog in the track-set on the ski trails.
- Skate Skiing is not permitted on the groomed and track set trails.
- Ski on the right side of the trail single file and not side-by-side to allow others to pass.
- Yield to faster skiers.
- Do not obstruct ski trails or intersections. Move off the track if you need to stop for a break or happen to fall.

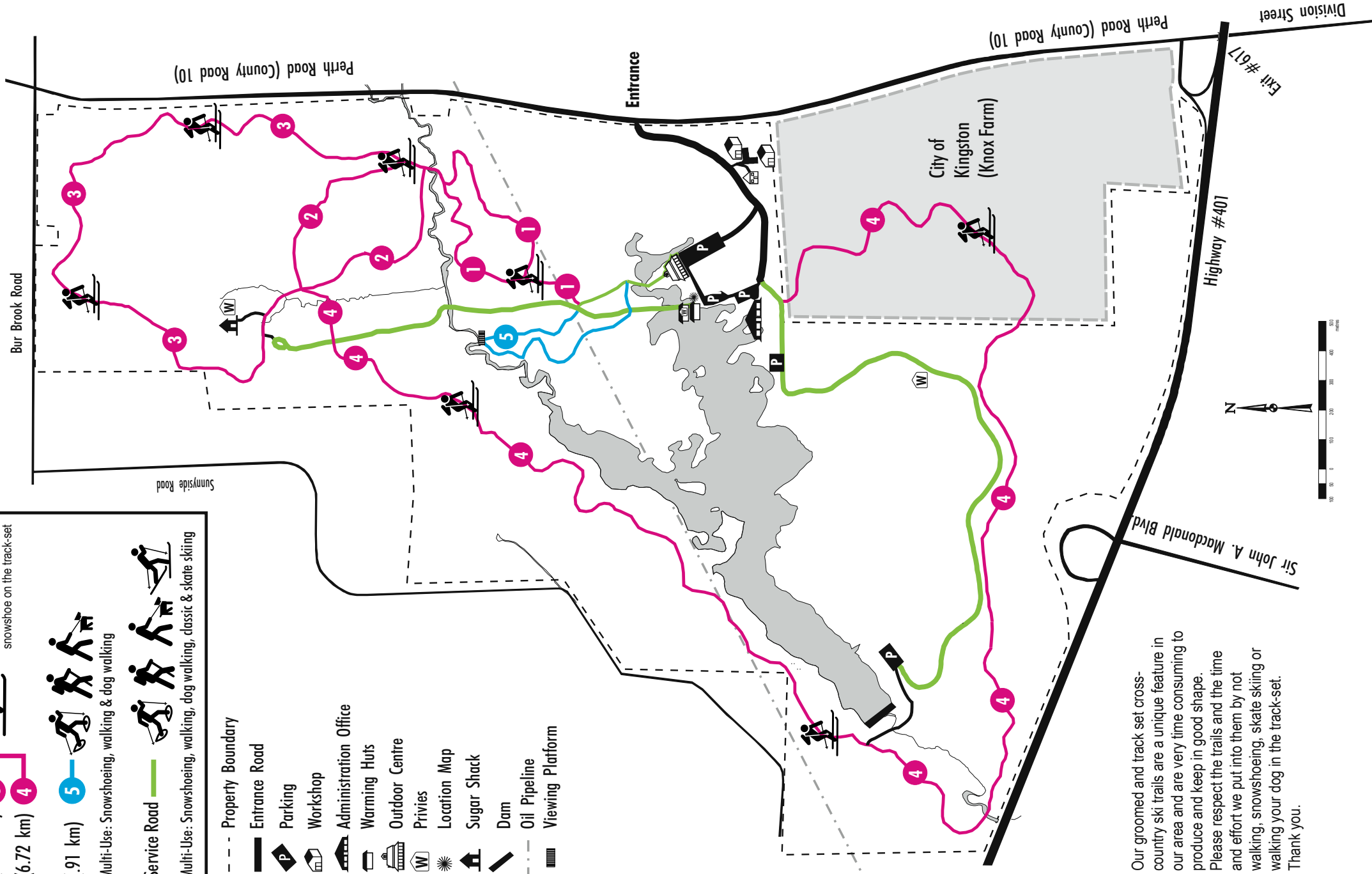
